*Face2Face Intermediate Workbook* (with key) accompanies the *Face2Face Intermediate* core text. The focus of the 12-unit workbook is on consolidation of vocabulary, grammar and real world language introduced in the core text. The real world section includes functions such as asking for and giving permission, and giving and responding to advice. The topics include weekend activities as well as technology and work. An extra feature over and above other workbooks is a special reading and writing portfolio, which develops the topic from each unit. The reading activities include multiple-choice questions, true/false questions and ordering paragraphs. The writing activities include formal and informal letters, sentence completion and descriptions.

### **Evaluation**

This workbook text is recommended as a supplementary material used in conjunction with the core text in class, or as a homework book. It could be used in both EFL and ESL classrooms, although it would be more suitable for international students studying in Australia rather than migrants due to its topics. It contains instruction in a core set of linguistic skills that could be used in any English speaking country, and the reading and writing portfolio gives students more exposure to language in use. It is this portfolio section which gives it the edge over other core text workbooks.

It would also be appropriate as a self-study book because it is fairly easy to follow and quite self-explanatory.
